NEIGHBORHOOD COVID AID

In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive." Acts 20:35 (ESV)

PBC's Neighbourhood Aid was started to enable our congregation to reach out, either individually or as a Care Group, to an increasing number of people who were laid off due to the EMCO, effective June 1st. Petty crimes and suicides began to increase as savings depleted and Covid-19 cases continued unabated.

By the end of June, netizens began a 'White Flag' campaign, encouraging people to raise white flags if they were in need.

Petrol Stations and grocery stores set up Food Banks, where people gave what they could so others could take whatever food they needed. Malaysians readily came together with the spirit of "Kita Jaga Kita" to support their neighbours so that none would go hungry.

On 18 July 2021, Pantai Baptist Church launched our own Covid Relief Fund (CRF). Members gave generously, enabling the church to reimburse volunteers for the groceries they bought and distributed to the needy.

"I did not realise so many families were in need ... just 10 minutes' drive from where I stay," remarked one sister. She had sent grocery packs to a few families at a nearby low-cost apartment complex.

Our Neighbourhood Aid efforts continue to surface many more who are in distress . . .

WHO ARE OUR RECIPIENTS?

Many are foreigners who had lost their jobs as construction workers, or were cleaners at shopping malls, coffee shops and restaurants; shop assistants, part-time maids and other casual workers. There were elderly Malaysians, whose children were too financially stretched to support them, and families under house quarantine, unable to shop online or have items delivered as they had no e-wallets to make payments. One lady had sold her phone to buy milk for her baby.

WHAT WERE TYPICAL ITEMS SUPPLIED?

Many people just asked for "*barang dapur*" or kitchen supplies which often meant the very basics like rice, cooking oil, sugar, instant mee, salt, flour and beverages like coffee and Milo for their older children. We also received many requests for infant milk powder and disposable diapers (relatively expensive items.) Some volunteers thoughtfully added veggies like onions, carrots, a head of cabbage, or potatoes to the standard supermarket food packs, or cans sardines or baked beans.

NON-FOOD ESSENTIALS AND SOME TOYS

A construction worker requested for bath soap and toothpaste. Another lady needed some dish washing liquid and laundry detergent. Although these were not food items, we included them in our packs.

A lady, from a low-cost flat, only requested for any kind of used toys. Her young children were bored, unable to go out for many weeks. She could only afford to spend on food, rent and utilities. Now we have collected some used toys from our Sunday School children to bless our recipients' kids.

SOME TESTIMONIES . . . FROM YOUNG ADULTS CG

I have always wanted to volunteer ever since this initiative kickstarted in July, but also constantly falling in the trap of procrastination. Sunday after Sunday, the sermons were clearly focused on missions, encouraging us to be salt and light of the world, but I kept telling myself, "*Okay, next week, next week.*" And it never happened until 2 weeks ago when I decided to obey and heed His call.

I picked up the phone and texted Sister Laina about my intention to volunteer. She patiently guided me through the process, and I was able to reach out to 3 families that day. The experience has taught me so many life lessons – one of them is that it's easy to get too focused on ourselves during times like this.*Cont'd next pg*
