1. Share your thanksgiving for the great privilege He has given you to be His son/daughter.

2. What observations can you make regarding the sexual immorality, impurity, and greed which almost become normalize in church and our life? What should we do about it?

3. Paul identifies two big areas of sins in our lives - fleshly desires and our fleshly speech. What have you found to be helpful in maintaining self-control in these two areas? Where do you still need prayer?

4. What is the difference between inappropriate humor and fun vs. a wholesome good time?

Why is foolish/ungodly speech not appropriate for the believer?

And how should we handle it when we're with others who speak in this manner?

5. Christ's love for you prompted Him to willingly sacrifice himself for you. What condition were you in when Christ loved you? [Hint: Rom 5:8]

How can you demonstrate this same kind of love to others?

On a scale of 1-10, how sacrificial is your life for others? What needs to happen for that number to be higher? [Hint: Read Romans 12:1]

6. What does it mean, practically, to "give thanks in everything?"

What is the rationale behind such an exhortation? Do you do this? Why/why not?

7. Why Paul commands us to imitate God (to be Christ-likeness)?

What is hindering you from imitating God more fully? How can you grow in this area?

8. Take a moment to thank God and pray for each other - ask the Holy Spirit help to live as a child of light and to imitate God (to be Christ-likeness) in this fallen world.
